Declaration of Restrictions for Savannah at Turtle Rock Association, Inc. recorded on November  
12, 2013 as Instrument Number 2013152318 in the Public Records of Sarasota County, Florida,  
as amended from time to time ("Declaration"); and,

2. All present and future Members of the Association shall be bound by the amendment to  
Section A of Article IV of the Articles of Incorporation as follows:

Article VI Board of Directors

A. The affairs of the Association shall be managed by a Board of Directors  
consisting initially of three Directors. The number of Directors comprising succeeding  
the Boards of Directors shall be as provided from time to time in the Bylaws of the  
Association, but in no event shall there be less than three or more than nine Directors.
